- Use captions during phone calls.
- Speak and read English fluently.

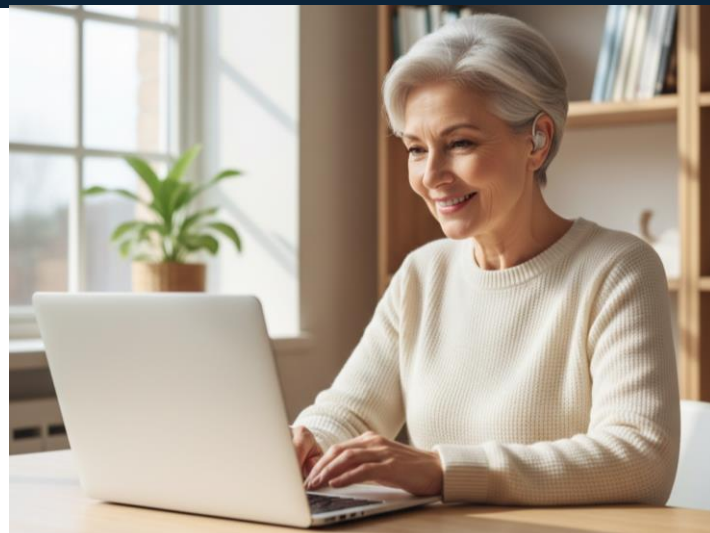
STUDY DETAILS
